

Indo-German Academic Exchange

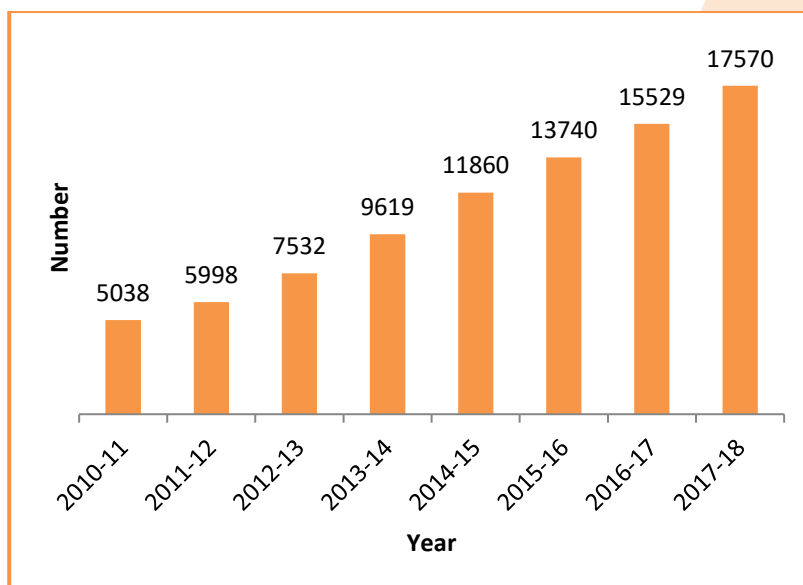

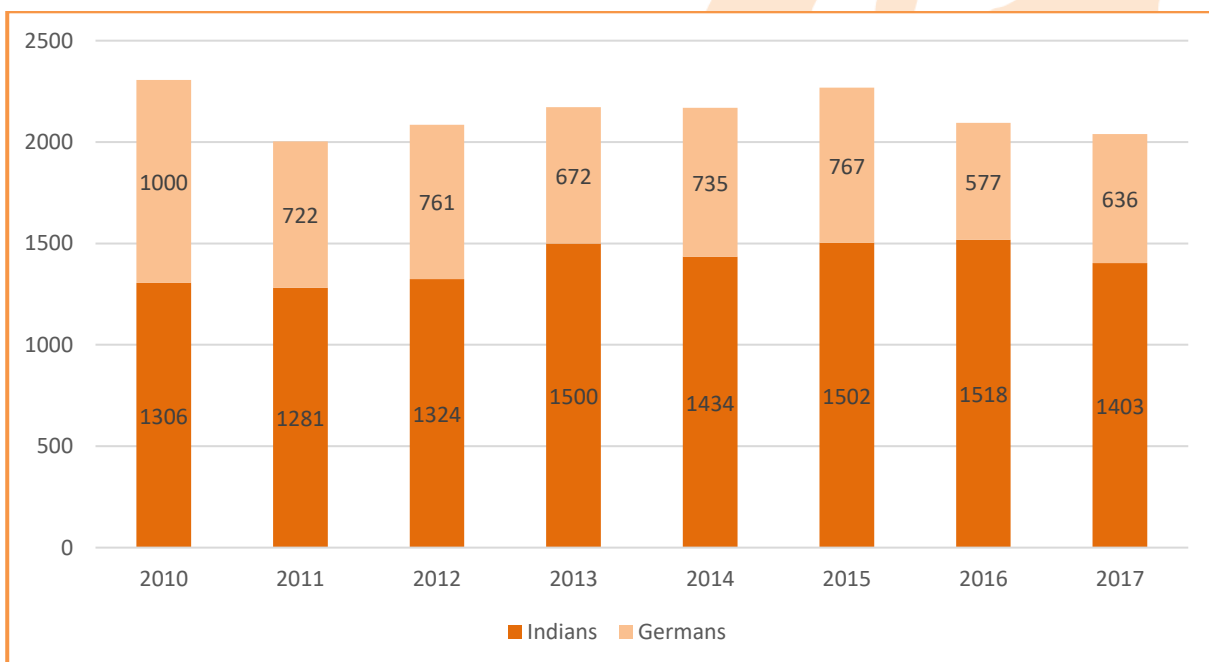
DAAD Strategy 2020
